## REMARKS:

An area of possible oil seen southwest of the Destroyed Taylor platform off the Birds Foot Delta. The slick extends to the southwest, is around 9 miles long and about 0.9 miles at the widest point. Currents match up well with the direction in which the oil extends toward the southwest.
