REMARKS: Suspected oil appears white and shimmery
and beginning at the location of the destroyed Taylor
platform. The area of possible oil extends 14km NE,
which is in agreement with ocean current and covers an
area of 23 square km. Due to the appearance and
location, there is high confidence this is oil.
