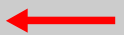

REMARKS:

The anomaly corresponds to the hotline that was opened for "Breton Sound 21 Well, Breton Sound, LA." The initial sheen on June 06, 2015 was estimated to be 37 gallons based on overflight sheen calculation. The anomaly seen in the image matches the coordinates that were given in the hotline. The sheen extends 5 miles and is consistent with wind speed and direction.
